CONDITIONS

1. Applicants for this grant must be full-time university students, resident in Spain, taking a degree course at a Spanish university related to the teaching of English.
2. Applicants do not have access to research funds or conference travel grants from their institution(s). Please indicate if you have applied for parallel funding from any other scholarships or grants.
3. The grant includes **free conference registration** as well as a **free one-year membership in TESOL-SPAIN** and is intended to help cover travel and accommodation costs up to a **maximum** of €250.
4. The grant will be paid by the Treasurer of TESOL-SPAIN, on presentation of original receipts for the costs claimed. Whenever possible, please ask for an invoice in the name of TESOL-SPAIN:

5. Applicants must send:
 - a copy of DNI
 - an academic record
 - a letter of recommendation from a teacher
 - a copy of their student ID



6. Applicants must fill out the “grant statement” section of the online presentation proposal form (250-300 words) explaining why they should be awarded the grant they seek.
7. The application letter must be included in the online proposal form and received by **15th October, 2020**.
8. A committee consisting of the Convention Speaker Coordinator, Regional Coordinator, Vice-President and President will select the winning candidate for each grant.
9. The decision of the grant committee is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Candidates will be informed of the grant committee’s decision by **mid November 2020**.
11. The successful candidate will be required to provide a report of their experience at the TESOL-SPAIN Convention or another article suitable for publication in our e-Newsletter no later than 2 weeks after the conference.
